English

We are looking at:

- Reading Set 2 sounds: ay, ee, igh, ow, oo, oo, ar, or, air, ir, ou and oy
- Reading multisyllabic words
- Predicting what might happen next.
- Responding to stories and questions with relevant comments, questions and reactions
- Showing understanding of characters, events and setting in narrative through pictures and writing

Maths

We will be exploring:

- Numbers to 20 and beyond
- How many now?
- Manipulate, compose and decompose
- Sharing and grouping
- Visualise, build and map
- Make connections

EAD

In EAD, children will be junk modeling and up cycling to make our own rockets and use collage materials to create their own Rainbow Fish.

Children will also be learning a dance routine and they will be encouraged to create their own dance moves. The children will also be looking at how we could 'write' our music down using picture prompts (circle means clap, etc.).

PSED

We are looking at Relationships and Changing me.

We will be looking at:

- Jobs my family do, how to make friends, how to be a good friend and how to solve problems to stay friends.
- Naming different parts of the body, understanding that we all grow from babies into adults and starting to talk about transitioning into Year 1.



UTW

We will be exploring:

- Stories from other cultures to explore different countries
- How children travel to school.
- Simple maps with simple features, land and sea, roads and houses etc .
- Space travel, NASA and significant historical figures who have been to space
- Coastal animals and sea creatures. How are they different to animals on land?
- What sand is and where shels come from
- Sinking and floating and how seawater is different
- fiction and non-fiction texts around contrasting environments

C&L

The children wil re-read some favourite stories we have used in previous learning to revisit and consolidate vocabulary and events. Children wil continue to develop sustained focus when listening to stories. They wil also be encouraged to predict events in familiar and unfamiliar stories, and making links between them.

The children wil take part in 'Show and Tel' with both photographs and special objects. The children wil then be able to talk about what they have brought in.

Music

This term, pupils will enhance their musical abilities through dedicated lessons with the specialist music teacher. They will be developing performance skills, building confidence and expression.

Books

Your child will be sent home with a new library and RWI book every Friday. We also read their phonics books and key words throughout the week so please ensure your child has their bookbag in school daily.

Forest School

Reception will have forest school this term every Wednesday. Please can you ensure children have:

- wellies
- old clothes you don't mind getting muddy
- rain coat (for when it is raining)
- sun hat (for when it is sunny)
