

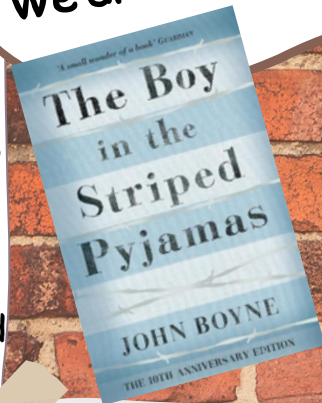
Fairway Primary Academy Summer Term in Year 6

Maths

We will be learning about:

- Ratio
- Position and direction
- Statistics
- Algebra

After we have completed our maths topics, Year 6 will be completing different themed topics such as creating/designing their own theme park.

RE

In RE, Year 6 will explore Islam through the theme of Beliefs and Meaning. They will consider the key question: Does belief in Akhirah (life after death) help Muslims lead better lives? Pupils will reflect on how beliefs influence choices and behaviour.

Science

Year 6 will be learning about circulation and health, exploring how the heart and blood transport nutrients around the body. They will also study electricity, building and testing circuits using batteries and switches.

They will also investigate are some sunglasses safer than others.



History

In history, Year 6 will explore unheard histories through the question: Who should go on the £10 banknote? Pupils will research significant historical figures, exploring their achievements and legacies.

They will learn how to use evidence to make inferences and apply criteria to decide who is historically significant, justifying their choices.

DT

In DT, Year 6 will take part in "Come Dine With Me", where they will plan and prepare their own dishes.

Pupils will follow and write recipes, measuring ingredients accurately and using the correct equipment.

They will also learn about where food comes from and how it reaches our supermarkets.

Music

Music will be provided through an external agency every Thursday.

PSHE

- In PSHE (Jigsaw), Year 5 will explore Relationships and Changing Me, learning about how relationships grow and change, and how their bodies develop as they get older. Pupils will also discuss feelings, respect, and how to manage change in a positive and healthy way.

Computing

In computing, Year 6 will explore Big Data and the Internet of Things (IoT).

Pupils will learn how data is shared across networks, including the differences between WiFi and mobile data, and why data is sent in packets.

They will also explore how data can be used to improve everyday life, such as in town planning, and design their own ideas for how Big Data could improve our school.
