

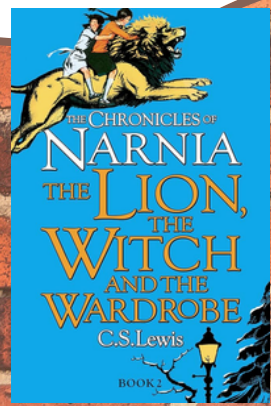
English

In English children will explore poetry through *The Malfeasance*.

Maths

We will be learning about:

- Decimals

Science

Year 5 will be exploring an exciting range of topics this term. In science, pupils will learn about life cycles and reproduction, understanding how living things grow and change. They will also investigate unbalanced forces through practical experiments to see how movement is affected.

Art

In art, Year 5 will use line, colour and tone to express emotion and movement. They will explore composition, including focal points and balance, and design their own prints. Pupils will experiment with different techniques, create printing plates, and reflect on how to improve their work.



Geography

In geography, Year 5 will explore the question: Would you like to live in the desert? Pupils will learn about hot desert biomes, including their location, climate and physical features. They will study the Mojave Desert, exploring how it is used and the challenges it faces. Children will also consider how humans interact with desert environments, including the impact of climate change, and compare deserts with other biomes. They will finish by discussing the advantages and disadvantages of living in a desert.

RE

In RE, Year 5 will explore Sikhism through the theme of Prayer and Worship. They will consider the key question: What is the best way for a Sikh to show commitment to God? Pupils will learn about different ways Sikhs express their beliefs in everyday life.

History

In history, Year 5 will explore the question: What did the Ancient Greeks do for us? Pupils will learn about key periods of Ancient Greece, including life in Athens and Sparta, and the role of democracy. They will also explore Greek gods and philosophy, and discover how the achievements of the Ancient Greeks continue to influence our lives today.

PSHE

In PSHE (Jigsaw), Year 5 will explore Relationships and Changing Me, learning about how relationships grow and change, and how their bodies develop as they get older. Pupils will also discuss feelings, respect, and how to manage change in a positive and healthy way.

Computing

In computing, Year 5 will explore stop motion animation. Pupils will create their own short animations, developing simple story ideas and storyboards. They will learn how to make small changes between frames to create smooth movement, add effects such as titles, and give helpful feedback to improve their work.
