

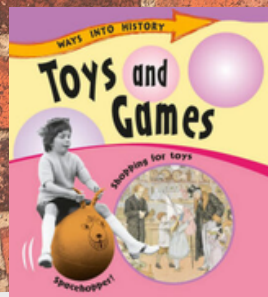
# Fairway Primary Academy Spring Term in Year 1

## Maths

We will be exploring:

- **Place value:** Understanding numbers within 50.
- **Addition and subtraction:** Performing calculations within 20.
- **Measurement:** Comparing lengths, heights, weights, and volumes.
- **Number bonds:** Recognising and using number bonds to 20.

## Science

We are scientists

- We will be learning about Animals Including Humans
- Identifying and name basic body parts
- Learn how to keep our bodies healthy and safe by practising good hygiene and understanding that medicines help us when given by a trusted adult.
- Describe and compare the structure of a variety of common animals, including pets.
- Group animals based on simple characteristics, such as what they eat or how they move.

## Art

We will be developing our art skills by learning to:

- Use simple paper-sculpting techniques to roll, shape and attach paper to make 3D art.
- Choose colours and patterns to decorate their sculptures creatively.
- Work with others and use basic tools like glue and paint to finish a sculpture.



## Geography/History

In Geography we are exploring what the weather is like in the UK.

The children will be able to identify the different weather symbols and match the weather to different seasons.

In History we are learning about toys from the past.

We will compare old and new toys. The children will experience old toys and explore how toys have changed.

## DT

We are inventors.

We will be designing and making our own pull along toy. We will learn to:

- Choose and use suitable tools to cut and shape materials accurately.
- Test and compare different wheel designs to see how they move.
- Design and label a simple product that meets a user's needs.
- Make and evaluate a pull-along toy, checking it works and suggesting improvements.

## Music

This term, pupils will continue to enhance their musical abilities through dedicated lessons with the specialist music teacher. They will be developing performance skills, building confidence and expression.
